



## 5<sup>TH</sup> WORLDWIDE ROSARY SCHEME OF ADORATION

February 20, 2023

### I. INTRODUCTION

MATER FATIMA and FRICYDIM, with the Marian Theotokos Movement and the Diocese of Yakima, Washington, USA, join together in the 5th Worldwide Rosary in the liturgical memory of Saints Francisco and Jacinta Marto.

We will present children to Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, with the need for their innocence to be cultivated, defended and preserved in the world.

We also want to ask the Lord, through Mary, for the following intentions:

1. The conversion of sinners, the peace of the world and the triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
2. Families, the nucleus of society and seedbed of vocations.
3. The Holy Father in his mission to guide the Catholic Church and the Renewal of the Consecration of Russia.
4. The missionaries, so that the fire of the Holy Spirit may lead them to evangelize in all corners of the world.

Let us remember the words of Jesus in the Gospel of Saint Matthew: *“Likewise, I tell you: if on earth two of you agree to ask for something, my Heavenly Father will grant it to you. For where two or three are gathered in my name, there I am in the midst of them”* (Mt 18, 19-20). All families united in prayer on this day are convinced that God will hear our pleas.

#### V. HOLY ROSARY JOYFUL MISTERIES

##### *First Joyful Mystery: The Annunciation of the Angel to Mary and the Incarnation of the Word.*

From the Gospel according to Saint Luke:

*“In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the house of David; the name of the virgin was Mary. And he entered where she was said: “Rejoice, full of grace, the Lord is with you... you will conceive in your womb and you will give birth to a Son, whom you will name Jesus”... Mary said: “Behold, the servant of the Mister; let it be done to me according to your word”. (Lk 1, 26-28.31-38)*

Saint Francis and Saint Jacinta Marto, are models of Holiness, they, together with the Blessed Virgin Mary, invite the world to give FIAT as



they themselves welcomed it, so that we may be guided by the Light and Grace of God.

We offer this Mystery so that the innocence, holiness and purity of all children may be preserved.

### ***Second Joyful Mystery: The Visitation of Our Lady to her cousin Saint Elizabeth.***

From the Gospel according to Saint Luke:

*"In those days, Mary arose and went quickly to the mountainous region, to a city of Judah; she entered the house of Zacharias and greeted Elizabeth. And as soon as Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, she was filled with the Holy Spirit." (Lk 1, 39-41)*

On June 13, 1917, the three little shepherds see Our Lady of Fatima in the midst of a great light and she promises salvation to those souls who embrace devotion to her Immaculate Heart. A heart outraged by the sins of humanity, which asks for reparation. In the apparition of July 13, the Virgin mentions the devotion of the first Saturdays as a means of reparation. Let us ask our Lady to bring us closer to her Immaculate Heart to compensate for the pain she suffers for the sins of men and the offenses against her Son.

### ***Third Joyful Mystery: The birth of the child Jesus in the portal of Bethlehem.***

From the Gospel according to Saint Luke:



*"Joseph and Mary left Nazareth for Bethlehem and, while they were there, the days of the delivery came to an end, and she gave birth to her firstborn son, wrapped him in swaddling clothes and laid him in a manger." (Lk 2, 6-7)*

God is the creator of the universe, and sole owner of the miracle of life. In the portal of Bethlehem he gives us the perfect family model. Joseph and Mary offer Jesus a home full of love. It is our responsibility to love and defend life from conception to the natural term. We ask that every child in the world be protected, loved and respected at home.

***Fourth Joyful Mystery: The presentation of the Child Jesus in the Temple and the purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary.***

From the Gospel according to Saint Luke:

*"When, according to the law of Moses, the days of purification were fulfilled, they went up to Jesus to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord, as it is prescribed in the Law of the Lord: "Every firstborn male shall be consecrated to the Lord". (Lk 2, 22-23)*

After the first apparition, Jacinta experienced in her heart a great love for the Holy Father, for whom she offered many sacrifices. The great longing to see him was manifested with innocence in his holy soul: "Who would make me see the Holy Father!" He said. One day he was granted to see him in a vision that is described as follows: "I have seen the Holy Father in



a very large house, on his knees, in front of a table, crying with his hands on his face. Outside the house there were many people: some threw stones at him, others cursed him and said very ugly things. Poor Holy Father! We have to pray a lot for him”.

This mystery is offered for the Holy Father in his mission to guide the Catholic Church and the renewal of the Consecration of Russia.

From the Gospel according to Saint Luke:

*“The child Jesus stayed in Jerusalem, unknown to his parents. After three days, they found him in the temple sitting in the midst of the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions.” (Lk 2, 43-46)*

Francis was greatly impressed by the words of the Angel: “Console your God.” In his illness, before dying, he confided to his cousin Lucia: “Will Our Lord still be sad? I am so sorry that He is like this. I offer him as much sacrifice as I can.” During his short life, he offered many rosaries for the conversion of sinners. May that of the children of Fatima transform us so that we can put our gifts at the service of God, asking him to give us the apostolic zeal of Francisco, Lucia and Jacinta.

We offer this mystery for the missionaries, so that the fire of the Holy Spirit ignites their hearts and leads them to Evangelize all corners of the world.

## VIII. CONSECRATION OF ONE-SELF TO JESUS CHRIST THROUGH THE MOST BLESSED MARY AND SAINT JOSEPH (ST. LOUIS MARIA GRIGNON DE MONTFORT)

O Eternal and Incarnate Wisdom! O sweetest and most adorable Jesus! True God and true Man, only Son of the Eternal Father and of Mary ever virgin! I adore Thee profoundly in the bosom and splendors of Thy Father during eternity, and I adore Thee also in the virginal bosom of Mary, Thy most worthy Mother, in the time of Thine Incarnation.

I give Thee thanks for that Thou hast annihilated Thyself, taking the form of a slave, in order to rescue me from the cruel slavery of the devil. I praise and glorify Thee because Thou hast been pleased to submit Thyself to Mary, Thy holy Mother, in all things, in order to make me Thy faithful slave through her. But, alas! Ungrateful and faithless as I have been, I have not kept the promises which I made so solemnly to Thee in my Baptism; I have not fulfilled my obligations; I do not deserve to be called Thy child, nor yet Thy slave; and as there is nothing in me which does not merit Thine anger and Thy repulse, I dare not come by myself before Thy most holy and august Majesty. It is on this account that I have recourse to the intercession of Thy most holy Mother, whom Thou hast given me for a mediatrix with Thee. It is through her that I hope to obtain of Thee contrition, the pardon of my sins, and the acquisition and preservation of wisdom.

Hail, then, O Immaculate Mary, living tabernacle of the Divinity, where the Eternal Wisdom willed to be hidden and to be adored by Angels and by men! Hail, O Queen of Heaven and earth, to whose empire everything is subject which is under God. Hail, O sure refuge of sinners, whose mercy fails no one. Hear the desires which I have of the Divine Wisdom; and for that end receive the vows and offerings which in my lowliness I present to thee.





I, (name), a faithless sinner, renew and ratify today in thy hands the vows of my Baptism; I renounce forever Satan, his pomps and works; and I give myself, Russia, and the whole world entirely to Jesus Christ, the Incarnate Wisdom, to carry my cross after Him all the days of my life and to be more faithful to Him than I have ever been before.

In the presence of all the Heavenly Court, I choose thee this day for my Mother and mistress. I deliver and consecrate to thee, as thy slave, my body and soul, my goods, both interior and exterior, and even the value of all my good actions-----past, present and future-----leaving to thee the entire and full right of disposing of me and all that belongs to me, without exception, according to thy good pleasure, for the greater glory of God, in time and in eternity.

Receive, O benignant Virgin, this little offering of my slavery, in honor of and in union with that subjection which the Eternal Wisdom deigned to have to thy maternity, in homage to the power which both of you have over this poor sinner and in thanksgiving for the privileges with which the Holy Trinity has favored thee. I declare that I wish henceforth, as thy true slave, to seek thy honor and to obey thee in all things.

O admirable Mother, present me to thy dear Son as His eternal slave, so that as He has redeemed me by thee, by thee He may receive me! O Mother of Mercy, grant me the grace to obtain the true Wisdom of God, and for that end receive me among those whom thou dost love and teach, whom thou dost lead, nourish and protect as thy children and thy slaves.

O faithful Virgin, make me in all things so perfect a disciple, imitator and slave of the Incarnate Wisdom, Jesus Christ thy Son, that I may attain, by thine intercession and by thine example, to the fullness of His age on earth and of His glory in Heaven. Amen.
